1. It was motioned by John Adams and Wayne Hahn to accept the agenda.
2. It was motioned by John Adams and second by Leia Ryan to approve the minutes of the February 25<sup>th</sup>, 2015 Meeting.
3. Alex Dickie addressed the council concerning the change in the setup for the Volksfest celebration. The council approved the setup on Thursday night, as long as the downtown businesses do not have any problems with the early set up. Motion made by John Adams and Second by Leia Ryan to approve the early setup.
4. Jeff Schneider from the Red Wing Incinerator gave an update on two matters.
  - A. First matter was the upcoming computer disposal which encourages citizens to participate in the computer disposal program and he handed out some flyers in the regard.
  - B. Mr. Schneider gave an update on the garbage disposal process in Goodhue. Currently Goodhue sends garbage disposal to the Red Wing Facility and it is processed and burned at the Xcel Steam Plant. The city expressed concerned about having a reliable and predictable garbage rate. After much discussion, Mr. Schneider will come back with a proposal for an approximately four (4) yearlong contract for the city to consider.
5. It is motioned by Leia Ryan and second by Tia Schimek to approve to send new firemen to fire school.
6. It was motioned by Leia Ryan and second by Tia also to send the other members to fire training classes.
7. Andy Brandel gave an updated pay request for the 3<sup>rd</sup> street project and also gave a brief update on the swimming pool.
8. The Mayor addressed the council regarding the request by the city of Bellechester to use city street sweeper to do street sweeping projects. This would include the employee to operate the machine. Motion was made by John Adams and Tia Schimek to allow city employees to conduct street sweeping process in Bellechester in the spring and fall and the cost of one-hundred-fifty-dollars (\$150.00) per hour.

9. Motion by Leia Ryan and Second by Tia Schimek to pay the bills, new providers motion by Wayne Hahn and Second by leia Ryan to adjourn.
