



## Miss Goodhue 2016

The Miss Goodhue Committee cordially invites you to participate in the 2016 Miss Goodhue Pageant! As you may know, being part of the Miss Goodhue Pageant is a fun and unique way to get involved in your community. Your participation is also a great way to spend time with friends, develop your interpersonal skills, and build your resume all while growing as a young woman.

The Miss Goodhue Pageant is the kick off to Volksfest happening on **June 10th**. We ask that you arrive around 6:00pm that night. Prior to the actual pageant, you will get to meet the judges and have an opportunity to talk with them one on one. This will take place the morning of **June 6th**. As a candidate or possible royalty, we ask that you spend some of the Volksfest weekend doing various activities - please keep that in mind.

Here are some other very important details pertaining to the pageant.

- Applications: You can download your application from the City of Goodhue website at your convenience. Fill out the application to the best of your ability, making sure to check for grammar and spelling errors. Applications and sponsorship money is due **March 18th by 3 pm** and should be turned into Mrs. Ebner's office. Late submissions are not accepted. If you run into technical complications, please contact us. All applications should be placed in a labeled, sealed manilla envelope.

- Sponsorship: You will need to ask a local business to sponsor you as you run for Miss Goodhue. You can begin to contact potential sponsors whenever you'd like. We suggest asking non-chamber members, such as home based businesses (daycares, jewelry consultants, make-up consultants, farms, 4-H Clubs, dance teachers, etc.) We are asking that your sponsor donate **\$65**. This money goes directly towards crowns, sashes, programs, and flowers. You are required to collect the money. Please place their sponsorship in your application envelope. Also, write your name in the memo of the check.
- Group and Individual Photos: This will be scheduled at a later time. We ask that you wear a long sleeved black top and jeans. Jewelry is optional, but it does photograph nicely! We will meet before school one morning. Please make all efforts to attend this time. Retakes are difficult to schedule.

- Community Event: Each year the upcoming candidates participate in a group community project. This year the Goodhue Education Foundation has reached out to us for help with their spring auction. It is not set in stone what activity you have to do, but the ideas we've had so far are a crazy hair or a nail station. If you have other ideas, let us know. This is **April 10th**. Time is to be determined at a later date.
- Judging Event: You will have the opportunity to meet one on one with the judges before the actual pageant. This will also include a light meal where you can interact with fellow candidates and the judges as well as fun activities. We ask that you dress in *business attire* during this event. This will be the morning of **Saturday, June 6th**.
- Rehearsal: We will have a time to rehearse your introduction as well as walking the runway. This will be **Thursday, June 9th** at 6:00pm. Your escorts do not need to come to this, but they do need to be present at **6:00pm on Pageant night** to run through their duties.
- Pageant Night/Onstage Question: We will be giving you a list of various questions that you will be asked on stage the night of the pageant. These questions will be somewhat serious in nature; the judges will be looking for a well thought out, complete answer.
- Pageant Night/Talent: In the past the candidates have done a group talent that the judges really enjoy watching. This year we are making that optional. If the group of you would like to do a single group talent, please contact us no later than **April 20th**, so we can get it in the program. As a committee, we think it's a great way to showcase another aspect of yourself and highly recommend thinking outside of the box and finding something to perform!
